

## St. Sebastian Portsmouth Award Scheme

The Portsmouth Award Scheme is recognition of an archer's ability shooting Indoor Portsmouth rounds during the winter season (1<sup>st</sup> November to 31<sup>st</sup> March) and applies to all archers, irrespective of age or ability and is for all bow types.

- The Portsmouth round is five dozen scored arrows shooting at 20yds distance using an 60cm diameter target face, 3 arrows per end and ten zone scoring.
- Awards are for scores in excess of 300, 325, 350, 375, 400, 425, 450, 475, 500, 525, 550, 575, 580, 585, 590, 595 and 600 (Maximum score is 600).
- We hold badges between 400 and 585. For badges 300 to 375 and 590 to 600 by special order.
- 3 sighters to be followed by the Portsmouth round.
- All archers need only submit one qualifying score to achieve the award.
- The score must be witnessed by a second senior (over 18) archer.
- Scores to be submitted (either using the Official Score sheet, or an archer's own score sheet) to the Records Officer or another club officer as soon as possible after achieving the score.
- Once an archer has claimed an award, subsequent awards must be for a higher award score.
- Successful archers may purchase a quiver badge of recognition of the relevant score at a cost of £2.50 (Special order badges at a cost of £3.50).
- When an archer achieves a higher score award, they can either purchase an additional quiver badge or they can "trade in" the lower award badge for the higher award badge (assuming the badge is undamaged) for 50p.
