



What 'Derbyshire County Archery Association' (DCAA) provides for its clubs and members

Club archers pay affiliation fees for DCAA membership every year, but what do you get for your money? Here is a brief outline of the types of activities and responsibilities that DCAA have:

- **Coaching** - Organises winter coaching sessions available to all members. Organisation of coaching development sessions for the county's coaches.
- **County Archery Teams** - Selecting archers to represent Derbyshire at inter-county competitions and provides a county team shirt for each competitor.
- **County Records** - Recording and verifying of new County records for all AGB recognised rounds. Supports members with the rules and regulation of archery.
- **Safeguarding** – Offers support and advice to clubs, and if necessary, handles Low Level Concerns and Disciplinary Issues. Refers Safeguarding issues to the relevant bodies.
- **DCAA Website** - Providing news and information on competitions, club information, records, documentation and contact details.
- **Competitions Organising** - Three County competitions are organised throughout the year plus involvement in regional competitions, with Derbyshire hosting these on a rota with other Counties in the region.
- **County Leagues** - Organises both Summer and Winter Leagues for Derbyshire clubs.
- **Regional Meetings Representation** - Elected delegates attend 'East Midlands Archery Society' (EMAS) meetings to represent Derbyshire.
- **Finance and Data** - Overseeing the income and expenditure of DCAA, including grants to UK/England representative archers and new clubs. Support clubs with subsidies and liaises with Region and AGB on evaluating data.
- **Development Group** - A group who work to promote and develop the sport of archery throughout Derbyshire, liaising with national and local sporting bodies and organisations.
